"I had nine girls in my cabin along with my co-cabin leader. On the night that we learned about how Jesus sees our mess, one of the girls shared her story. She shared about being sexually abused and how she still has those wounds. She also shared that we were the first people she felt comfortable sharing her story with. That was all Jesus. We prayed for healing over her and she said she felt a weight lift off her shoulders and felt more at peace than she had in a long time.

This week has been so good. I have seen and felt God's faithfulness this whole time."

Many youth come to camp carrying pain and hurt from their past. They hope for a better future. We know a better future is a future grounded in Jesus Christ; a future that is filled with life, love and peace. Our mission is to raise up lifelong followers of Jesus. Let's work to get even more youth who do not know Jesus to camp!

This ministry is so vital to seeing young people's lives changed. Please be in prayer as we search for a new Camp Director. Become a Team PRC Member

Become a Team PRC Member by making a three-year <u>monthly</u> pledge of \$25, \$100, \$500 or different amount, or making a three-year <u>annual</u> pledge of \$1,000, \$10,000, \$25,000 or a different amount.



Real Estate Donation:

The value of real estate can often greatly increase the size of your estate. A real estate donation entitles you to a significant current tax deduction and can reduce the value of your estate, which can save or eliminate estate taxes. It can also provide a lifetime monthly income.



Donation of Stocks & Mutual Funds:

Donating appreciated stocks or mutual funds can be a great benefit to both the donor and Prairie River Camp. As a donor of an appreciated stock or mutual fund, you are able to avoid paying capital gains tax on the appreciation of the asset. Also, as the donor of that security, you get to deduct the full fair market value of the security at the time of the gift, if you have held the security for longer

than 12 months.

You make an irrevocable gift, generally using cash, maturing CD's, or securities in exchange for lifetime guaranteed payments, the amount of which is based on the value of your gift and the age(s) of the payment recipients. In addition, the donor receives an immediate income tax deduction, and a portion of each payment is income tax free!
